## HIGH SCHOOL PATHWAYS

High School students can customize and choose their High School path based on their educational, career, and personal goals. There are two major options of study: **High School Graduation Pathway** and **College Prep Pathway**. Students who are in need of credit recovery can also create a high school plan to suit their needs through our online class offerings.

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION PATHWAY is for students who seek a flexible, blended high school learning environment. These students can enroll in online classes, courses taught at learning centers by approved vendors, community colleges classes, or engage in an independent home-study course. This pathway fulfills the requirements for a California State High School Diploma and those required by the District:

- 4 years of English
  - 2 years of Math, including Algebra 1 and Geometry
  - 2 Years of Science, including 1 physical and life science
  - 3 Years of Social Science, including World and US History, and a semester of Government and a semester of Economics
  - 1 Year of Visual or Performing Arts
  - 1 Year of Foreign Language
  - 2 Years of Physical Education
  - 1 Semester of Health
  - 65 credits of Electives
- Total: 220 credits

COLLEGE PREP PATHWAY prepares students for the next steps in their education at the college and university level. These students are aiming to apply to any public or private 4-year university directly after HS graduation. The number of requirements fulfill a state HS diploma, and indicate a student is “college ready” based on the widely accepted University of California recommendations:

- 4 years of English
- 3 years of Math, including Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II (4 years is strongly recommended)
- 2 years of Science, including 1 physical and life science and 1 laboratory class
- 3 years of Social Science, including World and US History, and a semester of Government and a semester of Economics
- 2 Years of the same Foreign Language
- 1 year of Visual or Performing Arts
- 1 semester of Health
- 2 Years of Physical Education
- 45 credits of Electives Total: 220 credits

\* For students planning on applying to any University of California or California State University, can choose an online curriculum for A-G approved courses.
